


## Race Weekend FAQ's

- What times do gates open?
  - o 7:00 am
- Can I buy a ticket at the gate?
  - Yes, you can buy tickets from the Will Call location in Lights Field or at the Outfield ticket booth. It is highly recommended to buy ahead of the event as it will make your entry to the event much faster and more efficient. The ticket booths are strictly for ticket scanning and bag check for this event.
- Do you offer any discounts?
  - No, veterans/active military are free with valid ID, & children ages 12 and under are also free
- What items are not allowed to be brought in?



ALL GUESTS AND BAGS ARE SUBJECT TO SEARCH. ALL OTHER ITEMS MAY BE REFUSED IF DEEMED INAPPROPRIATE OR UNSAFE AT THE DISCRETION OF MANAGEMENT OR ON-SITE SECURITY. ITEMS LEFT AT THE ENTRANCE GATE AREA WILL BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF BY SPEEDWAY STAFF. ALL GUESTS ARE ALLOWED TO LEAVE AND RE-ENTER BY SHOWING A VALID TICKET OR CREDENTIAL.

When can camping load in?

- o Thursday: 10:00 am 4:00 pm & 8:00 pm 10:00 pm
- o Friday: 6:30 am 10:00 am & 6:30 pm 10:00 pm
- Campers are only allowed to load in during the times listed above. Any camper arriving before or after the listed times will need to wait in general parking until the next load in window
- Are camping spots still available?
  - Completely sold out
- Can I purchase Infield Parking for the event?
  - No. Infield parking is not available to purchase for this event.
  - Reserved parking will only be available for those who require handicap parking, vendors, teams/crew, or those attending hospitality who received proper credentials ahead of the event.
  - Parking for general admission is on a first come, first serve basis in the
     Outfield and in Lights Field off the 60 White Hollow Road entrance.
- Is off-site parking available for this event?
  - Yes, parking is available at various locations in close proximity to the track with a shuttle bus service running pick up and drop off to the track. Full list of locations available on our website www.limerock.com
- Is there Wi-Fi available for fans throughout the event?
  - WiFi is available to guests ONLY at the two entrances/ticketing locations. It
    is highly advised to screenshot your ticket QR code on your phone and/or
    print out your ticket QR code at home from a desktop computer.
- Can I bring a pop-up tent?
  - Pop-up tents are only allowed in very limited areas in the back row of spectator viewing areas; this is highly enforced.
- If it rains, can I get my money back?
  - o No, NASCAR Trucks race in the rain
- Can I buy a garage pass?
  - No. Garage and Pit passes are credential access only.
- How many races are happening/ how long?
  - There will be track activity consistently over the two-day race weekend, including three different series. NASCAR Classic (HSR) will race Friday and Saturday. ARCA and NASCAR Craftsman Truck Series will race on Saturday.



- Is there somewhere to eat?
  - Yes, there are multiple concession stands and food trucks around the facility.
- Is it a long walk from the parking area to the Infield?
  - o It depends on where you park. There are various free golf cart courtesy shuttles running consistently all weekend making various stops around the track from the main entry. The Outfield will be a farther walk for fans as they will need to cross the pedestrian bridge to the Infield.
- Is there a grandstand or assigned seating?
  - No, we are a track but also a park! The seating on the hillside is first come, first serve. Many fans enjoy moving around to different viewing points throughout the day. It is recommended that you bring a chair or blanket.
- Are the paddocks open to fans?
  - No, A paddock will contain the ARCA/NASCAR garage area which will be fenced in and is credential access only.
- Are dogs allowed?
  - No, unfortunately a hot, incredibly loud racetrack is not a safe place for our furry friends that we all love so much! PLEASE leave them at home!
